SBFFA Alumni Scholarship

\$10,000 @ least up for grabs to 5 graduating seniors

1000 point system based off participation in your time as a high school student

1 Essay

General and Officer Positions

- Number of years of paid FFA membership:
 - 10 Points per year Maximum 40 points
- Number of courses of agricultural science instruction completed by applicant:
 - 5 points per course Maximum 50 points
- FFA Offices Held:
 - 10 points per chapter office; 20 points per office above chapter level. Maximum 50 points

Livestock Projects (Max 125 Points)

- Spring Branch FFA Show and Sale
 - 10 Points Per Project 5 additional points for winning Grand or Reserve Champion
- Shows other than Spring Branch FFA Show & Sale:
 - 5 points prospect
 - must be confirmed with an AST and points awarded
 - 15 points county
 - 20 points for winning overall county Grand or Reserve Champion;
 - 20 points major
 - 25 points for winning major Grand or Reserve Champion;
 - record highest level of achievement per show

Non – Livestock Projects (Maximum of 125 points)

- Spring Branch FFA Show & Sale:
 - 10 points per project
 - 5 additional points for winning Grand or Reserve Champion
- Shows other than Spring Branch FFA Show & Sale:
 - 5 points-prospect;
 - 15 points-county;
 - 20 points for winning overall county Grand or Reserve Champion;
 - 20 points-major;
 - 25 points for winning major Grand or Reserve Champion;
 - record highest level of achievement per show)

<u>LDE/CDE/SDE Events</u> (Maximum of 125 points)

- 10 points-invitational;
- 10 points-district;
- 15 points-area;
- 20 points-state;
- 25 points-national;

<u>FFA Awards and Achievements</u> (Maximum of 125 points)

Star, Proficiency, DeKalb Award, Herdsman, Top Hand, Ford Leadership Scholars, Outstanding Member, Lonestar, Chapter Degree, Greenhand, Showmanship:

- 5 points-chapter;
- 10 points-district;
- 15 points-area;
- 20 points-state;
- 25 points-national)

*Awards & Achievements are the 2nd tie breaker

<u>FFA Sponsored Community</u> <u>Service</u> (Maximum of 125 points)

Santa's Farm, MD Anderson Blood Drive, Pennies for Patients, Homeless Bags, SPCA, Can Food Drive, (Green Points)

• 5 points each

*This is the first tie breaker

FFA Sponsored Activities: (Maximum of 125 points)

Conventions, School Visits, 360 Influence, Washington Leadership Conference, Day at the Capitol, CDE/LDE camps, Brunch at the Barn, Community Tuesday, MFE Conference, LDE Bowl, AET Help Day, Barnyard Shooting Sports:

- 5 points-chapter;
- 10 points-district;
- 15 points-area;
- 20 points-state;
- 25 points-national

SBFFA ALUMNI AFFILIATION (Maximum of 20 points)

Parent/Guardian's years of membership during the applicant's high school years in SBFFA:

• 5 points each year; same point value for 1 or 2 parents

OTHER SAE RELATED ACTIVITIES (Maximum of 40 points)

Examples such as: Work Placements, Exploratory, Agri-Science, Agri-Business:

• 5 points per event per semester - Must be in your AET Books

Essay (Maximum of 50 points)

SBFFA Alumni Scholarship

Example Scenarios:

140+ scholarships awarded annually

STUDENTS MUST TAKE AND SCORE A MINIMUM OF 1000 ON THE SAT OR 19 ON THE ACT TO BE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY

Awarded based on academic and FFA achievements and performance in an interview process.

Advance from District and Area to the State level

3 years in FFA/SAE - Must Receive Lonestar

Must be in the upper half of academic ranking. Some require upper ¹/₄ ranking.

CDE/ASF: 10 points total

- Level of success, increased participation, improvement in placing, number of years participating
- 1-4 District, 5-7 Area, 8-10 State/National

Invitational: 5 points total

- At least 1 Invitational event every year they are an FFA member
- Showed growth or success by increasing personal or team placings

Officer or Committee: 5 points total

- Office and committees are equal
 - 1-2 Chapter
 - 3-4 District
 - \circ 5 Area or Higher

Other FFA and Community Service : 10 points total

- This is community service and general FFA activities
 - \circ ~ 7-10 State and National Events
 - 4-6 District and Area Events
 - 1-3 Chapter Events

SAE: 10 points total

- Entrepreneurship (animals, lawn care business, selling honey or eggs),
- Placement (working at a Vet, Tractor Supply),
- Research (Comparing chicken feed on growth)

Need Narrative: 10 Points

Academics: Possible 15 points

National FFA Scholarships

900+ Scholarships awarded annually. Over \$1.5 Million awarded in scholarships.

Scholarships range in size from \$500 to \$10,000 and several are renewable for up to four years

FFA activities and work experience; leadership and service activities; as well as academic record. Financial need and other specialized criteria are considered on selected scholarships as required by the sponsor.

FFA MEMBER APPLICATION SCORING RUBRIC

Academic Achievement - 20 Points Maximum

- GPA Score (20 Points) (GPA X 5 = X)
- Based on a 4.0 scale

Non-FFA Clubs & Extracurricular Activities – 10 Points Maximum

- A maximum of 5 unique non-FFA extracurricular activities may be provided
- 2 Points awarded per activity

Non-FFA Honors and Awards - 10 Points Maximum

- A maximum of 5 unique non-FFA extracurricular activities may be provided
- 2 Points awarded per activity

FFA Leadership Experience – 20 Points Maximum

- · A maximum of 5 unique FFA leadership experiences may be provided
- 4 points awarded per activity

Community Service/Service-Learning - 10 Points Maximum

- · A maximum of 5 unique Community Service/Service-Learning experiences may be provided
- 2 Points awarded per activity

Supervised Agricultural Experience (SAE) - 20 Points Maximum

- A maximum of 5 SAE experiences may be provided
- 4 points awarded per activity/project that details: description of activity/project, length of Involvement and goals and skills achieved during participation

Non-FFA Work/Internship Experience - 10 Points Maximum

- A maximum of 5 unique Work/Internship experiences
- 2 points awarded per activity

SELECTION NOTES:

Through our partner at ISTS, National FFA uses application scores resulting from batch scoring along with individual scholarship sponsor criteria to determine the top qualified applicants for individual awards. Additional review of specific application components may be required depending upon the criteria of the individual scholarship for which selection is taking place. All selection decisions are final and are not subject to appeal.
