What Do We Do?

- Shotgun shooting team, breaking clay discs moving through the air
- Participate in different shotgun events, which are generally:
 - Sporting Clays
 - Trap
 - Skeet
 - 5-Stand
 - Others: Super Sporting, FITASC, Whiz-Bang, Doubles Trap
- Compete against other individuals, FFA teams, and 4-H teams. Event awards are given at the individual and team levels.
- Shooting sports is part of the Wildlife, Fisheries and Ecology Management curriculum for FFA.

Goals

- Have fun & BE SAFE. Fun and safety are the two core elements of the program and are part of everything we do.
- Develop personal skills, teach rules & best practices related to shooting and shotguns.
- Enjoy the outdoors and have fun shooting with the team at different locations.
- Continue to bring the sport of shotgun shooting to Spring Branch FFA students.
- You get out of it what you put into it.
- Be competitive and build on past program success.
- Win a State FFA Banner!!

Safety

• ALWAYS point the gun in a safe direction

• ALWAYS keep the gun unloaded until ready to use

• ALWAYS keep your finger off the trigger till ready to shoot

Tools & Equipment - Guns

- Need to have access to a gun (own or borrow)
 - Need to buy a new one? Come to first practices to try a few out. Also talk to Mr. Barker or Mr. Johnson
- Type
 - Over / Under
 - Semi-automatic
- Wood, synthetic or camo your preference!
- Gauge
 - 12 ga Preferred
 - 20 ga good
 - Stay away from 16, 28 and 410
- Chokes Light modified or improved cylinder, modified, and skeet will be all you need for most events

Tools & Equipment – Ammo

- How much am I going to need?
 - Each tournament: 100-200 shells
 - Larger, multi-event tournaments like SALE will require more
 - Practice: 50-200 shells
 - Try to buy in Cases (250 shells / case) or Bricks (100 shells)
- Type
 - 7½ or 8 shot, nothing larger than 7½
 - 1 oz or 1 1/8 oz load (7/8 oz for 20 gauge)
 - Reloads Okay for practice, generally not for tournaments
- Who has ammo? Academy, Carter's Country, Briley, etc.
 - Briley and Carter's recently have had cases, limit of 1 case / person / day
 - Academy recently has had cases with a 4 unit limit
 - Now is a good time to stock up on ammo for the rest of the year!

Tools & Equipment – Other & Clothing

- For eye and ear protection there are a lot of options at varying price points:
 - Ear Protection
 - Foam/molded/electronic
 - No ear muffs, can interfere with gun
 - Eye Protection
 - Recommend actual shooting glasses over sunglasses
 - Many shooters like multiple lenses for cloudy vs sunny conditions
 - Prices vary significantly from \$10-\$900
- Each athlete will also need
 - Shell Bag or Shooting Vest we will have a team vest from Barepelt available
 - Jersey one is required. (We need Team Sponsors!! see Team Sponsor Form)
 - Closed toe shoes tennis/running, boots, hey dudes
 - Weather appropriate clothing

Organizations

- Need to join the following organizations:
 - Spring Branch FFA
 - SCTP Scholastic Clay Target Program Allows us to compete in youth only shoots for individual and team awards
 - NSCA National organization for sporting clays. Throughout year, I'll recommend NSCA shoots. These are excellent development opportunities with more challenging targets
 - ATA American Trap Association. ATA has a youth only organization AIM.
 Join both.

- Texas State Hunter Education (or Wildlife Management Course)
- Other requirements listed in SBFFA Shooting Sports Contract
- iCEV Ducks Unlimited Certification (by 3/31/2023)
- Parent/Guardian Involvement
 - Not a drop and run sport
 - For students that can drive, need to have one parent/guardian at practice until I'm comfortable that son/daughter knows how to be safe
 - SCTP Tournaments need a few parents to attend to help with scoring and trapping
 - Parent/guardian to attend out of town tournaments (San Antonio)
- Register for Band app (look for invite) Communication!!

How Much Does This Sport Cost?

- Team Dues: \$150 (may be waived with sponsorship)
- SCTP/NSCA/ATA Memberships: ~\$70
- Jersey: Order at least one (either short sleeve or long sleeve) ~\$70/each
- Vest: Strongly suggested, Barepelt (\$125-150)
- Tournaments: \$75-\$200 in registration for each one
- Practice:
 - Kickapoo: Clay cost included in team dues
 - Other clubs: \$0.30 to \$0.60 per target
- Ammo: \$90-110 / case of 250 shells
 - 100-200 per tournament
 - 50-200per practice
- Travel Costs for San Antonio
